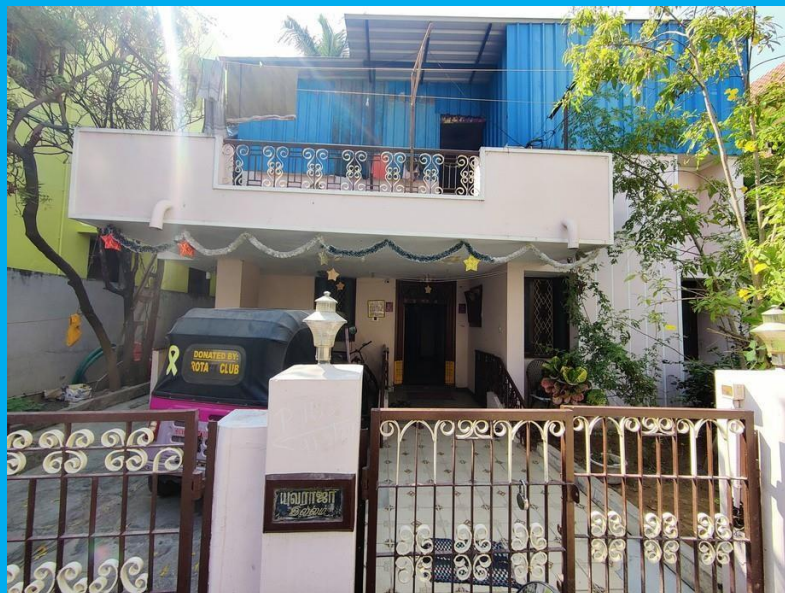

RESTORATION

Jerendiran is 65 years old man. He has a mental disorder. Volunteer Mr. Mukesh Jain saw him on the roadside and contacted us over phone. Immediately our team reached him and gave him the first aid he needed. Then we brought him to our JAL Ayush Old Age Home and provided him with food and shelter. We kept him under our surveillance for 15 days. After that we admitted him to a Mentally retarder Home in Villupuram. We are very happy to report that he is doing well now.



EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT

B. Sathesh is 10 years old boy. His parents are Mr.Baskaran and Mrs. Geetha. His father has separated from them because his mother is mentally ill. His uncle heard about our home through a volunteer and asked him to help with his education.



Presently, Master Sathesh is studying in class 5 at Gorimedu Indira Nagar Government School in Puducherry. We are very happy to inform you that we are providing all necessary assistance for his schooling on behalf of our JAL Shine Home.



SUCCESS STORIES

MASTER TUBANAMAL is 12 years old boy. His parents are Mr. Sujithmal and Mrs. Mangalammal. He has one younger brother. They belong to the West Bengal. His father is a milk salesman and his mother is a housewife. Master Tubanamal is studying in 5th standard. His parents referred him to the West Bengal's

Government Hospital as he had frequent fevers. At the hospital they advised to go to Puducherry Jipmar Hospital.

Jipmar's doctors tested him and found he had B-Cell Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia. As his parents are unable to rent a house alone due to financial

problems, they came to stay in 30th March 2020 after learning about our SHINE CANCER Children's Home.

During his stay in our SHINE CHILDREN'S HOME he was given proper nutrition and physical care and regular treatment his health improved day by day. Now after 25 months of care he is fully recovered and was sent back to his home.



R. LAKSHMI is 16 years old girl. Her parents are Mr. Ramesh (Late) and Mrs. Uma. She has one elder brother and one younger brother. They belong to the Chidambaram, Tamil Nadu. His mother working as a daily labour. She started having frequent dizziness and headaches when she was studying in ninth standard. Her mother treated her at a government hospital in Chidambaram.



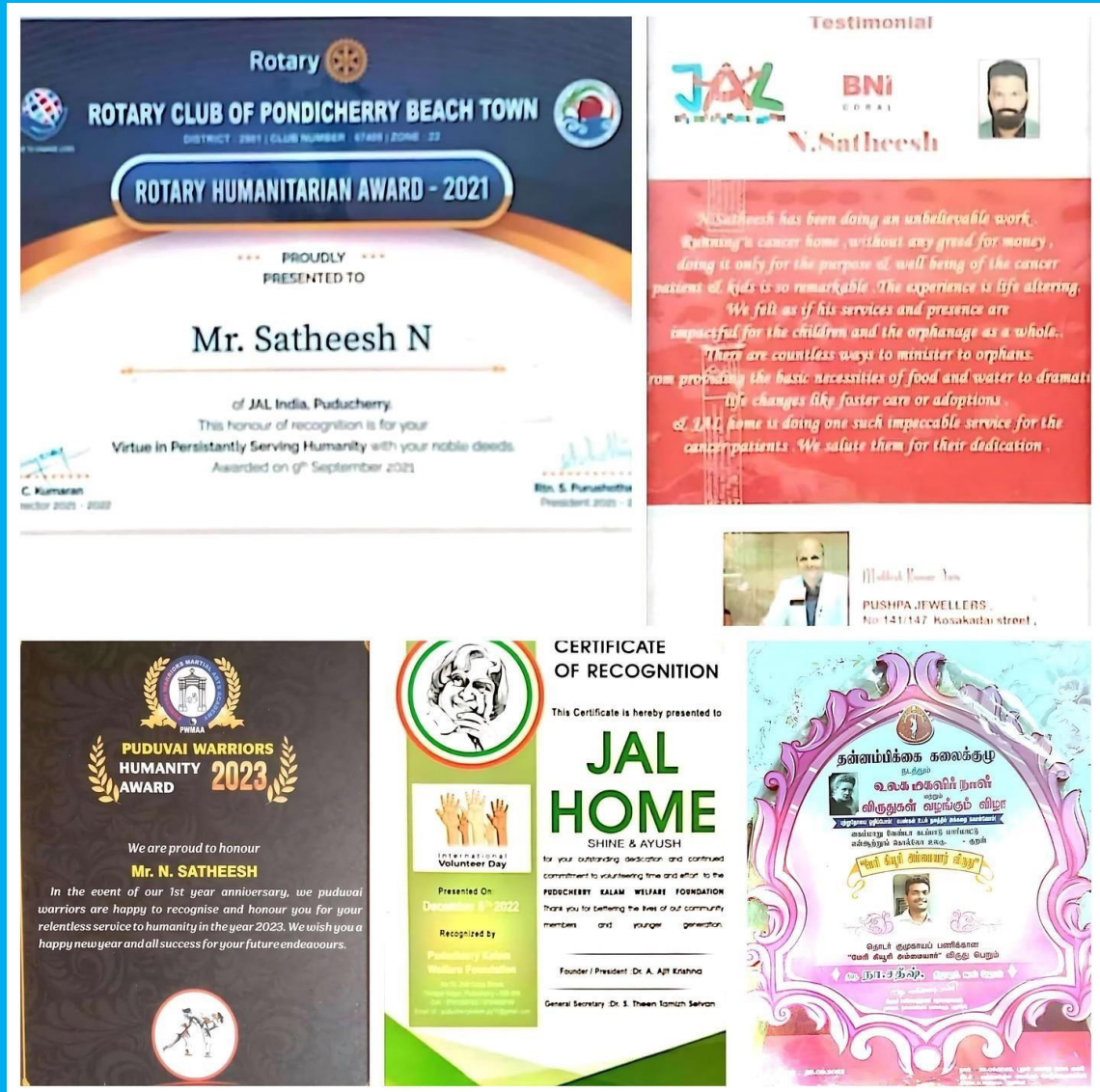
However, her condition did not improve and the doctors referred her to Jipmar Hospital in Puducherry. Here she was tested and diagnosed with T-Cell Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia. Since she needed to be treated immediately and could not visit her hometown often, the Jipmar doctors referred her to our Shine Cancer Children's Home. She joins in our home on 04th September 2019. Her mother could not stay with her for long months. Because there was no one to take care of her other two children, the mother had to go to her hometown. Her mother left her in our care.



On behalf of our JAL Shine Home, we are proud to say that after a period of 5 years, she has successfully completed her treatment after giving her proper care, nutritious food at right time, hope to fight the disease and continuous medical monitoring. She is currently studying in class 12 focusing on her studies.
